

ALL STAR'S IMAGE TIPS

You never get a second chance to make a first impression.

It's a mistake to underestimate the importance of your appearance.



- Well tailored, professional two-piece suit. Solid dark colors are preferred. The best style for most women is a straight skirt that ends at the knee. The jacket can be fitted or unstructured depending upon your body type. Blouse should be contrasting and conservative.
- Shoes should be plain pumps with no more than a 1½" heel. Shoes should be polished and in good repair. The color should blend with the outfit.
- Purses should be businesslike, unobtrusive, neat and clean.
- Pantyhose should be skin-colored, black or navy blue.
- Jewelry should be simple. Do not wear dangling earrings.
- Glasses should fit your face with clear lenses. Out-dated frames can blow your whole look.
- * Nice (well put-together) accessories give a "polished" look.

* Do not wear anything that clings, shines or makes noise.

- Hair should be clean and well-styled. Long hair should be pulled back — no extreme styles such as "big hair" or the moussed "wet look".
- Makeup should be natural-looking. Neutral colors work well (especially in eyeshadow). Makeup should be well-blended and not overdone. Eyebrows should look natural and not drawn on.
- Wear only matte finish lipstick, not frosted or exaggerated.



- Brush teeth and use a mouthwash.
- Any noticeable facial hair should be eliminated.
- Do not use any perfume or heavily scented fragrances of any kind. Use an unscented deodorant.
- Nails should be clean, well manicured with no more than ¼" beyond the fingertip. They should not be pointed or have artwork that would be noticeable or distracting. Polish should be in a subdued shade with no chips.
